YWCA Sonoma County is seeking a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist or Licensed Clinical Social Worker as an Independent Contractor to provide group clinical supervision for Associates and Trainees and individual supervision when needed.

Compensation: \$50/hour

Responsibilities:

- Provide Individual supervision to MFT Trainees, MSW Candidates, Associate Marriage and Family Therapists, and Associate Clinical Social workers.
- Meet with associates and clinicians as needed on an individual basis.
- Provide two hours of group supervision, as needed.
- Attend monthly clinical supervisor meeting with the Therapy Program Manager and other contracted clinical supervisors.
- Provide considerate and direct feedback to the clinicians regarding clinical work on a regular basis.
- Communicate regularly with the Therapy Program Manager and work collaboratively to meet program needs and resolve issues or concerns as they arise related to the Associates and Trainees.
- Regularly review and co-sign client files including assessments, treatment plans and session notes.
- Must ensure that the clinicians comply with all BBS regulations, guidelines and state requirements.
- Must meet all BBS regulations to provide clinical supervision and maintain personal liability insurance.
- Complete the YWCA's 40 Hour Domestic Violence Counselor training within 6 months of hire.
